



## GENERAL CLEANING:

**DO:** Rinse your canvas with fresh water after each use. For a more thorough cleaning, mix a gentle soap like Woolite® or Dawn® with water; use a soft cloth to clean windows and a soft brush to clean canvas if needed. Follow with a fresh water rinse and allow to air dry.

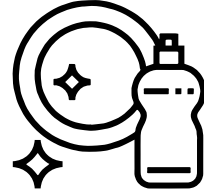
**DON'T:** Put Sunbrella or Stamoid products through a washer or dryer. NEVER use harsh detergents, window cleaning sprays, RAINEX®, solvents such as acetone, or cleaners that contain alcohol or ammonia. Don't let bird droppings or other stains remain long to avoid permanent damage.



## ZIPPER & SNAP CARE:

**DO:** Periodically wash all zippers with soap and water, then rinse with fresh water, and apply a silicone-based lubricant to zippers and snaps to prevent salt buildup and corrosion. Remove dirt and dust buildup on snaps in your canvas and on your boat.

**DON'T:** Leave your canvas permanently zipped/snapped on! Zippers and snaps can become difficult to use or seize up permanently if left unused or unmaintained. Don't use petroleum jelly or WD-40 on snaps or zippers.



## CLEAR VINYL WINDOW CARE:

**DO:** Regularly use a clean, soft cloth to wash dirt and salt off windows to maintain window clarity. Store windows dry and flat, with a protective layer such as a bedsheet between each window. Scratch-resistant coatings do provide protection, but vinyl windows are sensitive, and can easily scratch if mishandled.

**DON'T:** Fold, crease, or bunch up vinyl windows! Don't leave windows rolled up any longer than necessary. Don't store dirty/wet windows, as this can cause scratching and mold. Don't handle with sunscreen on your hands, as this can cause clouding. NEVER lay windows on an unprotected surface such as a dock or the deck of your boat
