



# MAKROLON POLYCARBONATE WINDOWS: PROTECT YOUR INVESTMENT

## DO:

- Rinse windows off with warm water prior to cleaning to remove salt crystals.
- Use a mild boat soap or detergent and soft cloth or mitt to clean windows.
- Wash cleaners off windows immediately.
- Follow cleaning with a warm water rinse.
- Use a soft cloth to periodically polish windows with Mirror Glaze Plastic Polish.
- Store windows clean, dry, and flat when not in use.

## DON'T:

- Use abrasives, high-alkaline cleaners, or gasoline to clean.
- Apply cleaners in direct sunlight or elevated temperatures.
- Use paper towels, scrapers, squeegees, or razors.
- Bend or pinch windows; this can cause micro-cracks in the finish.
- Over polish—it can wear down the protective coating.
- Let bird droppings and other stains remain long without cleaning.
- Handle windows with sunscreen or other lotions on hands.
